



ANATOMY OF THE CLOUD

an interactive art workshop by Blak Douglas

Students are presented with a powerful Power Point presentation acknowledging political facts, social justice issues & identity.

Artistic focus on debunking stereotypes in First Nations arts, whilst conversely introducing participants to the 'movers & shakers' of Aboriginal & Torres Strait Islander contemporary art practices.

Students then embark on creating a signature Blak Douglas 'flat - bottom cloud' through a brief tutorial. Learning the metaphor behind the use of these clouds in his award winning paintings. A fun activity for ages 12 & up (unless assisted by a guardian).
